Hello Dayana

Thank you for your consideration so far and for reaching out for more information regarding the canvas.

Yes, we certainly considered having the students paint straight on to the wall, however considering the risks involved with having young children on scaffolding, decided against. Unfortunately the Pre-Kindergarten children are a little too small to reach far up the wall from standing and are only just developing confidence making marks at chest height on paper in the classroom.

Amanda Husband has kindly investigated many options for our canvas wall hanging and has discovered a long-wearing, 'long-term' canvas that is designed to outlast all temporary options. It comes with a 2 pac clear finish and is fitted with metal surrounds to improve durability as outlined in links below.

Although this is a costlier option in the long run, we are confident this will be a safe and long lasting option to display the children's art work and create a welcoming entry to the ELC space. Funding Request Overview: Junior School family subscription to participate in the Parenting360 course

Submitted by: Steve Coventry, Head of Junior School

<u>Aim:</u>

To provide all Junior School families with access to Parenting360, an innovative, online parenting course and in-person workshops.

Introduction:

This is a funding request for \$10,000 for workshops and subscription costs, to access the

Parenting360 program.

The Parenting360 course is designed to equip parents with the knowledge and tools necessary to foster a supportive and understanding family environment, tailored to the unique needs of each child. This program stands out for its personalised approach, focusing on nurturing confident, compassionate young individuals by understanding their inherent and unique biological make up. This course will complement the ongoing professional learning Junior School teachers are undertaking with Dr Cam McDonald and Learn360.

We believe this partnership with Learn360 and the access to Parenting360 can make a significant difference in our community, fostering an environment where every child feels understood, supported, and encouraged to thrive.

Regrettably, this initiative falls outside of our Junior School budget parameters, but we are actively seeking alternative avenues to make this course accessible to all Junior School parents. <u>Background information</u>:

Over the past 18 months, Junior School staff have been working with Dr Cam McDonald and

Learn360 to better support each child to be their best selves. The work teachers are undertaking

provides an incredible framework that has allowed each educator to see more of the natural

strengths in each child and focus on celebrating these strengths in many different ways. This is

designed to help each student establish a strong sense of self, understand and take advantage of their natural strengths, better navigate their behaviour and optimise their learning environment.

The work has been incredibly well received by Junior School teachers and also the parents who were able to see Dr Cam present to families on the 29th of January. Dr Cam is also presenting to parents on Tuesday 20 February at 4pm, which we encourage Parents Association to attend if they wish to gain more insight into what is being offered.

Teachers have been working with Learn360 for 18 months and an important next step is expanding this information out to the wider school community, i.e. our Hutchins families.

A wonderful outcome for 2024 is the Junior School are part of groundbreaking research in precision learning with Learn360 (Southern Cross University, Parents International), this research has allowed us to support our families at a much lower expense than normal. As such, an extraordinary opportunity has arisen through our collaboration with Learn360, whereby we are able to provide each family with the Parenting360 program, the home-based complement to Learn360 for schools, for a heavily reduced rate.

The collaboration with Learn360 presents an incredible opportunity for The Hutchins Junior School, not only because of the potential benefits to our school community but also due to the significant discount offered to us. By participating in this research, we have the chance to access the Parenting360 program at a fraction of the usual cost.

Typical pricing for the Parenting course and child profiling is: AU\$750 per family. Full price, this would cost our school and it's 300 families >AU\$200,000. Due to the research support, we are able to provide this to the whole Junior School for AU\$10,000, 5% of the normal cost.

This initiative is especially valuable because it aligns with our school's commitment to holistic education, supporting not just the academic but also the emotional and physical wellbeing of our students and their families. The program offers a unique lens through which parents can view and understand their children, enhancing family dynamics and contributing to a more cohesive school community.

The parent feedback from the initial parent session, on 29th January by Dr Cam, has shown that there is a strong desire for this program, the research and the home-school connection. Hence our proposal to the Parents Association.

We believe this partnership with Learn360 and the access to Parenting360 can make a significant difference in our school community, fostering an environment where every child feels understood,

supported, and encouraged to thrive. We warmly invite the Parents' Association to consider this proposal and support us in bringing this invaluable resource to our school.

Thank you for considering this special opportunity to enhance the wellbeing of our families and contribute to the positive development of our school community.

Benefits to the school and students (what need does it address):

Proposed Outcomes/Benefits:

- In the 2021 MMG Hutchins parent survey, 33% Year 2 and 65% Year 6 parents felt the school did not provide sufficient opportunities for parents/carers involvement in their child's learning. This initiative would significantly address this parent concern.
- Our school strives to be leaders in education and embrace the opportunity to have a 'point of difference' in the educational opportunities' we provide. These cutting edge presentations, research and parenting course for families is a unique offering by our School. Within the Tasmanian and national independent school network, Hutchins is being viewed as a leader in education for our current work with Learn360. Adopting the Parent360 course will further enhance our standing as a leading independent school.

Parenting360 course provides clear insight for parents of the following:

- *Physical health:* Specific food, movement and sleep recommendations
- **Expected behavioural tendencies:** reasons for certain behaviours, strategies to support behaviour through a strengths-based approach and providing what the child's biology needs Behaviour: rather than just what they say they want in the moment.
- **Thriving:** Specific parent strategies for building a child's sense of self, resilience, stress management
- **Parent relationships:** Provides insight into how the parent can gain further insight into their health and biases that can influence the parent-child dynamics
