Dear Parents/Carers

The lockdown in Southern Tasmania will end at 6.00pm today (Monday 18 October) with some restrictions remaining in place until 6.00pm, Friday 22 October.

All students will return to classes at school tomorrow. All co-curricular programs, school events and activities planned prior to the lockdown will also resume.

All students in Middle and Senior School are required to wear a mask at all times. Students who are 12 years of age and in Year 6 are not required to wear a mask whilst at school, but must wear a mask whilst travelling to and from school. Masks must also be worn if students 12 years and older are visiting someone else's home. All staff are required to wear face masks throughout the day.
