

Cyril Henry Eagle Knight Science Scholarship

About

This scholarship is for current or new students entering Years 9–12. It is for up to 50% of tuition fees and tenable to completion of Year 12.

Biography

Cyril Henry Eagle Knight was born 10 August 1905 and enrolled at Hutchins on 3 February 1920 (no. 2437). In 1923 Cyril won the Imperial Challenge Shield for rifle shooting and passed the Qualifying Examination. He passed away in 1968.

In 1978, Cyril's widow, Kathleen Alice Knight, endowed a scholarship for a boy 'wishing to study science' to memorialise her late husband. Upon her death, 1991 saw a second scholarship endowed, again with reference to science, and remaining funds in 1996 saw the naming of the C H E Knight building at the School.

Selection criteria

The awarding of the scholarship will be determined by a process conducted by the Head of Science, as well as an interview.

Each candidate will:

- Undertake a science aptitude test – the School's Science Faculty will administer the test and mark it.
- Submit a resume showcasing what they have done in science. The resume must include, but is not limited to:
 - a) any investigations the applicant has done;
 - b) what competitions the applicant has been in; and
 - c) any additional co-curricular science activities they have undertaken.

Selection process

All applicants will be acknowledged. Based on the results of the testing and after review of the applicant's resume, interviews will take place with the School Registrar and Science Faculty staff. Parents/carers may not be present in the room during the interview.

Not all applicants may proceed to an interview and The Hutchins School reserves the right to not award the scholarship if no suitable candidate is found.

Terms and conditions

The holder of this scholarship is required to:



- Undertake at least one pre-tertiary science subject in Year 11 or 12.
- Participate in other science activities as directed by the Head of Science.
- Work to the best of his abilities at his studies, be a contributor to the life of the School and not bring discredit upon the School.

Failure to fulfil any of the responsibilities above may result in forfeiture of the scholarship at the discretion of the Headmaster.
