STAFF



- TASC Awards - 2025 leavers; Lucas Baumwol, Tian Li and Kevin Shen were each awarded a TASC Outstanding Academic Achievement Award for attaining an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) of 99.5 or above. Joshua Fielding was also presented with a TASC Outstanding Achievement in VET Award.
