Principal's Report

The School has completed a series of external audits, all of which have gone well. The audits include CRICOS (International student enrolments), Final Safeguarding Children Accreditation, NCCD funding audit (funding for students that qualify for additional support), and mid-school registration visit from the Non-government Schools Registration Board.

Thank you to the PA for their support of all four Grandparents' Days. We are experiencing greater community engagement than ever before with between 350 and 400 grandparents at each event.





Head of Mathematics vacancy - has been advertised internally for semester two/until end 2025. Position will be advertised substantively/externally to commence 2026.

The School currently has two student psychologists on UTas placements (supervised by UTas) on site two days per week until end of term 3. The student psychologists can undertake assessments of students referred to them by teachers (in consultation with our Head of Inclusive Education, Ms Deb Lie). At the conclusion of term 3, the School has been approved for another two/new students to commence for a further two-term placement.

National Reconciliation Week was celebrated in the Junior School with students transforming their classroom doors into vibrant, meaningful works of art. Each class explored what reconciliation means to them and brought their ideas to life using sustainable materials. At the Middle School Assembly, Mr Lucas Simpson shared his cultural heritage and insights, reminding us of the importance of listening to stories, learning from the past, and walking together towards reconciliation. In Senior School, lesson change bells were replaced by music from First Nations artists.

MMG Survey – opened to parents/carers on Friday 6 June. Parent/carer feedback is very important as we aim to improve in areas of opportunity and consolidate areas going well.

Reinterment service was held at Cornelian Bay Cemetery on 11 June. Of the 200 people in attendance, many travelled from inter-state. Feedback has been overwhelmingly positive from relatives of those exhumed. A final report on exhumations has now been completed and submitted to the Regulator of the *Burial and Cremation Act 2019*. The report is now available publicly on the School website.
