1. John Groom – Director of Advancement

It has been a big year in the Advancement office. They have raised over 6 million dollars, some of that amount is related to funds pledged over the next few years. The Signature building is the priority of the Master Building Plan, so is the proposed Pool and facilities.

2. PA subscription cost for 2023. It is currently \$35 per year per family. It is optional. Next year we will be communicating more to the Parents about what this money is used for. It is proposed that we continue with the same amount for next year.

3. Richard Davies – PEP and Friends of Hutchins. One of the main aims is to support new Parents at any grade level. Generally supporting Parents for any issues they might have related to Schooling at Hutchins.
