I have briefly outlined the Association's activities for the year below.

Jan-Feb

• We started the year with a new Headmaster Dr Rob McEwan, and have been pleased to welcome Rob and his family to the Hutchins community.

March

- The 4th annual Blokes and Spokes was held with over 200 boys and a special bloke enjoying the day. This popular event allows members of the school community to come together in a relaxing and social environment. It was fantastic to see the involvement of students, particularly prefects, middle school boys and gap students in the running of the event.
- The school held two Open Days and members of the PA assisted by hosting a BBQ at the weekend open day.

May

June
