The Hutchins School is partnering with Box of Books for digital and physical education resources for 2023. Stationery items will continue to be purchased through Office National, information regarding that will be sent separately.

You may already have School prescribed texts in hard copy. You will still require the digital version of the text on Box of Books however this can be purchased at a discounted cost.

If your child does not have the digital version through Box of Books, they will not have access to the additional resources made to the texts from the School teachers.

Steps to order

1. Visit [Box of Books Shop](#) to create a new account.
2. Add each student, including their school email address if possible, and select school and year group.
3. Select the items you wish to purchase from the booklist shown.
4. Use the checkout to organise postage direct to your nominated address and complete payment.

Digital versions of the texts will be available in your child's Box of Books account immediately after purchase.

To ensure delivery of all available physical items for the start of the academic year, please order by Friday 9 December 2022.
