2016 Winner - Will Priestley ('03)

We congratulate Will Priestley our very first YAA winner. In 2010 Will became Australia's latte art champion and travelled to London to represent Australia placing second in the World Latte Art Championships. After managing eight cafés in Melbourne Will returned home in 2011 and opened Pilgrim Coffee in Argyle Street. Will is now a partner in numerous businesses – Pilgrim Coffee, Aloft, Bright Eyes and The Standard employing over 70 staff. Recently Will won the Almond Breezy Masters Award and is now set to take on the world again competing in the US and London later this year.
